Instead of presentations to local schools' FT artists, there'll be an exhibition of their work; their awards were presented in their schools so as not to keep the children waiting for too long. You'll also find refreshments, home baking, stalls with FT information and fairly traded/Fairtrade crafts and foods, FT tastings, a Smoothie bike where you can pedal yourself a FT drink, children's activities, and almost always a bonus chance to collar your local politicians too.

Stalls earn for FT producers. We're also sending a donation from other profits (baking etc) this year to 'Toilet Twinning', because more than 2 billion around the world still have no loo.
