The organist usually plays for about 10-15 minutes before the service starts. Please liaise with the organist regarding the order of music.

Music is played during the Signing of the Register. Couples may choose a piece from the list or play their favourite song from a CD. If you bring a soloist, there will be an extra £50 fee, including one rehearsal prior to the wedding. Sheet music must be provided at least two weeks before the ceremony.
