Lay Rep Report

Eco-Rep Report: Church Heating – Summary of Changes and Observations

Over the past 12 months, the church has felt warmer than the previous year, despite using the same far infrared heaters. Several factors may have contributed to this:

1. Heater Position Adjustment

The heaters were lowered from their original too-high position, likely in **Autumn 2023**, improving their effectiveness.

2. Door Heaters Use

Heaters above the two main doors were occasionally used **before services**, providing both physical warmth and a psychological sense of warmth as people entered.

3. Sacristy Heating for Organ Care

A plug-in heater on a timer was used during very cold periods in the

sacristy near the organ to improve air circulation. Currently, a **fan** on a timer continues to circulate air, though without heating.

4. Old Heaters

The older heating system remains non-functional and will require an **electrical upgrade** to be usable again.

5. Energy Management

To avoid unnecessary use, the infrared heaters (which have **frost protection mode**) were **switched off at the mains** when the building was not in use

With the **Mar Thoma church no longer using the building**, overall energy use has also reduced.

6. Thermostat Observations

The system was set to **16°C** during a recent service. Heaters automatically turned off when that temperature was reached and came back on when it dropped, indicating the system is responsive and efficient.

7. Energy Saving Suggestions

- Switch off the third heater on each side when only 20–30 people attend and encourage seating nearer the front. This could save 9–12 kW over a 1.5–2 hour service.
- Consider using the hall when the temperature has stayed below
 5°C in the week leading up to a service.
